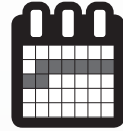


# CROSSING THE DIGITAL DIVIDE

Improve Consultation Speed and Accuracy with Digital Pathology

## TRADITIONAL PATHOLOGY CONSULTATION WORKFLOW



Time for consultation:  
**One week or more**

Day 1

Pathologist determines need for second/expert opinion.

Assistant pulls tissue blocks, slides, and report for pathologist.

1 Hour

Pathologist reviews material.

Need recuts?

Blocks and request for recuts are sent to Histology. When completed, slides are routed back to pathologist.

Pathologist selects the relevant material and forwards to assistant.

Day 3 or 4

Package arrives at consultant's office. Case is accessioned and routed to appropriate pathologist.

Assistant prints out request letter and packages the material for courier.

Day 1 or 2

Consulting pathologist reviews the case. If needed, the consultant will contact the sending pathologist by phone to discuss the case.

Consulting pathologist reports the diagnosis in the laboratory's LIS.

Requesting pathologist's office receives the fax of the final report and forwards it to the pathologist.

Assistant prints out the final report and faxes a copy to the requesting pathologist.

Day 4 or 5

The consulting pathologist's office packages the slides and case material for courier.

Requesting pathologist's office receives the case material. Assistant unpacks and refiles blocks and slides.

Week 2

## PATHOLOGY CONSULTATIONS USING CORISTA'S DP3™



Time for consultation:  
**One hour**

Day 1

Pathologist determines need for second/expert opinion.

Slides are sent to Histology for whole slide scanning.

Slides are scanned, and the case is accessioned into the Corista DP3™ platform. Case is immediately available for review by consulting laboratory.

Within Minutes

Triage administrator at consulting laboratory assigns the case to the appropriate pathologist.

Consulting pathologist reviews case. If needed, an online discussion of the case can be initiated with synchronous or asynchronous viewing of the case.

Consulting pathologist reports the diagnosis in the laboratory's LIS.

The consultant's LIS and the Corista DP3™ Platform are interfaced. The report is immediately available for review by the requesting pathologist in DP3™.
